ORDER FOR PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION

This cause came on before the Court for hearing on December 29, 2016, on the Plaintiffs Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, and the Court having reviewed the Motion and the accompanying affidavit, and the Complaint filed herein, and also having reviewed the Defendant's Response to the Plaintiff's Motion and having heard oral argument on the matter. Good Cause appearing.

Pursuant to I.R.C.P 65(e)(1) and (2), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction is GRANTED, and Defendant is hereby enjoined from December 29, 2016 and (through the duration of this litigation / until further ordered by the Court) from doing any of the following:
 - a. Contacting or communicating with people or entities in Idaho or on the internet concerning the criminal history of the Plaintiff(s);
 - b. Contacting or communicating with people or entities in Idaho or on the internet concerning any allegations of wrongdoing by Plaintiffs;

- c. Contacting or communicating with Plaintiff CandaLee Parker's school, employment, or church leaders concerning her criminal history or alleged wrongdoings.

This order does not restrict the Defendant from communicating with individuals for the purpose of obtaining witnesses including those listed above, to testify in this matter, as long as this communication does not communicate disparaging information from AnnetteKaye Casady to the persons contacted.

2. The Defendant is also hereby ordered to hide from public view the website www.casadyvsparker.com and any other online post, blog, or website that she has authored or created which violates the terms mentioned above for the duration of this litigation or until the Court further orders.

It appears to the Court that the Plaintiffs are entitled to the relief demanded, and that relief consists of restraining the commission or continuance of the acts complained of, and further that the Plaintiffs may suffer great or irreparable injury if the conduct of the Defendant continues before all claims are adjudicated.

This injunction is enforceable by all remedies provided by law.

Violation of this Order may result in a finding of contempt of court, punishable by fine and imprisonment, and the court may also impose other sanctions that may include an award of attorney fees to the other party.
